This study tour proposal is to offer a **special chance to go & learn “at the source”** from those who have developed and have been successfully applying and for years the TPM methods and the management principles finalized to the attainment of economic results and corporate development.

The TPM Executive Journey is focused on capital intensive companies that wants to apply a comprehensive system to manage the company and reach their business results.

We want our participants to:

- Watch **live and outstanding application of the TPM pillars** such as Focused Improvement and kaizen activities and see a system organized to continuously sustain improvement;
- See live how prevention can be the **turning point in corporate asset management**, to increase reliability and reduce life cycle costs; through Autonomous Maintenance and Planned Maintenance activities;
- Learn **how to create an involving system** for all the people inside your company and how to **activate autonomous cross-functional management** to increase know how sharing and training speed;
- Understand **how to apply the TPM principles and pillars** at one's own company, following the pillars' steps.

The trip is addressed to **entrepreneurs, managers and TPM coordinators** of manufacturing companies having already started a transformation path with a *TPM program* or willing to evaluate the opportunity of implementing it.

The participants will be helped and guided in Japanese territory by expert consultants of JMAC Europe and of **JMAC TPM Company** (former JIPM-S, the consulting branch of the **JIPM**, the developers of TPM) who will foster the focalization on the most important points of the visits through moments of preparation and of collective reflection.

The **Japanese JMAC TPM Company consultants** are professionals with several years of experience, and are the developers of the original TPM methodology.

Particular importance is placed on direct communication and debate with the consultants and managers from the company visited: to facilitate the conversation with our teachers and guides the group will be accompanied by **an interpreter** of JMAC Europe, with a deep knowledge of both the language and the topics being considered.

- In-depth visits to four companies **applying a TPM Program**. Each visit will be focused on a different kind of industry and pillars application and will be followed by a panel discussion among participants for reflection and summary of what could be observed.
- The pattern typical of each visit includes:
 - Presentation of the company by a local manager usually accompanied by a consultant from JMAC TPM Company
 - Explanation of the main **innovative aspects** and methods shown during the visit
 - **Safety** Instructions
 - Guided tour to the production departments
 - Final **debriefing** session with the possibility of asking questions to Japanese managers and JMAC TPM Company consultants.
- Each visit will be focused to explore some key aspects of the management for the implementation of a TPM Program:
 - **Focus on Improvement and kaizen** approach on machinery
 - **Autonomous Maintenance and Planned Maintenance**: build reliability of equipment by prevention and people involvement
 - **Policy deployment**: how to split company targets to machine level.
- **Seminar** on the principles and latest applications in TPM will be held at the headquarters of JMAC Tokyo, followed by a **discussion and a view exchange** among the participants about the "lessons learned".
- One day off (Saturday) for shopping and sightseeing.
